

# Guide to taking a photo of your pet's paw:



## Get your pet ready.

For dogs we recommend having two people and some treats on-hand, and getting them to lie down so you can position their paw.

For cats we recommend waiting till they are asleep!



## Consider lighting, angle and focus.

Natural light is best and recommended.

Be wary of using a zoom as this can drop the quality and detail of the photo.

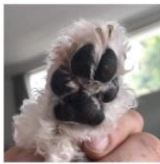


## Take a photo of your pets paw.

The better the photo, the better the final result.

Photos are fine to be taken on a phone with a good resolution camera.

If you can zoom in on the photo and see detail of the paw then the photo will be good enough.



## Measure your pets pawpad.

From the top-most part to the bottom-most.

You can use a ruler or measure-tape.

This is so we can ensure accurate true-to-life sizing of the print.



## Email the Images.
